GLTC Board Maintains Sunday Service; Final Vote Scheduled for April 1st, 2026

March 4th, 2026

The Greater Lynchburg Transit Company (GLTC) announced today that its Board of Directors voted to postpone changes to Sunday service at this time. Sunday service remains in effect across all GLTC service modes.

GLTC has been reviewing potential service adjustments as the agency continues addressing operator staffing challenges that can create unexpected disruptions and affect service reliability. This review has included an extensive public engagement process, with multiple public hearings and community meetings held to gather rider feedback.

The Board will hold a final vote on the Sunday service status at its next regular meeting on April 1st, 2026. The additional time will allow GLTC staff to research and evaluate alternative solutions that could preserve Sunday operations while supporting dependable service across the system.

"We understand how important Sunday service is for our riders. This additional time will help us examine more options and bring forward the best recommendation for riders and the community — one that balances rider needs, staffing capacity, and long-term service reliability." GLTC will continue recruitment and retention efforts in the coming weeks and will provide a full update at the April 1st, 2026, Board meeting.
