It is with tremendous pride that I share the outstanding results from the 2026 Virginia State Bus Roadeo, held on March 10th, 2026. Our operators and maintenance team competed against transit agencies from across the Commonwealth and represented Greater Lynchburg Transit Company with excellence, professionalism, and distinction.

GLTC earned 1st Place in the Operator Team Standings, with our team scoring 1,738 points out of 3,000 possible.

The four GLTC operators who contributed to this accomplishment were:

- * Moveeta Hairston — 6th Place Overall (459 points / 61.2%)
- * Nikki Silby — 7th Place Overall (449 points / 59.9%)
- * Sam Lawson — 9th Place Overall (441 points / 58.8%)
- * Crystal Garner — 18th Place Overall (389 points / 51.9%)

Competing against 37 operators from across Virginia, all four of our team members finished in the top half of the field.

Our maintenance team also delivered an outstanding performance, earning 2nd Place in the Virginia State Bus Maintenance Roadeo with 1,477.5 points out of 2,225 possible. The team demonstrated exceptional technical knowledge and consistency across multiple competition areas, including top finishes in several categories.
